

INFORMATION ACCORDING TO GDPR 2016/679 REGULATION

EMSO ERIC, with registered office in Rome (RM), in via di Vigna Murata, n. 605, VAT No. / CF 97908370584 (hereinafter, "Data Controller"), as data controller, informs you pursuant to art. 13 Legislative Decree 30.6.2003 n. 196 (hereinafter, "Privacy Code") and art. 13 EU Regulation n. 2016/679 (hereinafter "GDPR") that your data will be processed in the following manner and for the following purposes:

1. Subject of processing - The data controller processes personal identification data (for example, name, surname, place and date of birth, residence, telephone, e-mail, tax code, etc.) - later, "personal data" or even "data" communicated by you in connection with the registration to the EMSO Conference, according to the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights.

2. Purpose of processing - These personal data will be processed in compliance with the law. Specifically, these data will be processed for the following purposes, in relation to legal, tax, insurance and statutory obligations:

- A. to comply with legal obligations;
- B. to proceed with registration;
- C. for the purposes strictly connected and instrumental to the management of relations with the participants.

3. Processing methods - The processing of personal data takes place by manual, computerized and telematic means, with pre-established processing and organization logics and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the security, integrity and confidentiality of the same in compliance with organizational measures, physical and logical as provided by the current regulations. According to the art. 4 n. 2 of G.D.P.R, the processing of personal data may consist of the collection, registration, organization, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data.

4. In relation to the need for profiling and communication of the activities of EMSO ERIC - Your personal data will be subject to permanent processing and storage in your archives for the following purposes:

- D. for the purposes of promotion functional to the activity of EMSO ERIC, such as the promotion of cultural initiatives, social promotion, the sending of any publications or newsletters
- E. for the organization of the promotion of EMSO ERIC activities as well as for research, studies and related statistical analyzes
- F. use of photographic material and / or video for educational and informative purposes - EMSO ERIC intends to publish some multimedia material produced during the EMSO CONFERENCE. The release form is requested at the time of registration. Shooting will be possible; can be made of the souvenir photos that will be published on the site, <http://emso.eu/>; may also be published on the site and on the social networks (Instagram, Facebook, etc.) of the photos to witness the Conference.

With regard to the above, we wish to inform you in advance that the processing will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of the privacy and rights of the subscribers, in contexts that absolutely do not affect the dignity and personal dignity in compliance with current legislation. The data processing will also respect the limits established by the Regulation for the treatment of sensitive and judicial data prepared with D. M. n. 305 of 7.12.2006 and published in the Official Journal n. 11 of 15.1.2007 and of the GDPR 679/2016. The publication of said photographic material and / or video footage is to be considered free of charge by releasing EMSO ERIC from any economic task and from any liability concerning an incorrect use of personal data

provided and photos by site users or third parties. EMSO ERIC is released from any direct or indirect responsibility for damage to my image.

5. Duration of storage - Personal data is stored for the entire duration of the relationship and / or mandate and, in the event of revocation and / or other type of termination of the relationship, in the prescribed terms indicated in art. 2220 of the Civil Code. You may at any time exercise your rights: access to personal data; to obtain the rectification or cancellation of the same or the limitation of the processing that concerns them in cases where this configates with other provisions of the law; to oppose the processing; to oppose data portability; to revoke the consent, where provided for in cases where this does not conflict with other provisions of the law: the revocation of the consent does not prejudice the lawfulness of the treatment based on the consent given before the revocation; to make a complaint to the Privacy Authority.

6. Your rights - You may at any time exercise the right to oppose, for legitimate reasons, the processing of data, request its updating, rectification and cancellation, by sending an e-mail to privacy@emso-eu.org , specifying in the subject "**request for updating and / or rectification, and / or cancellation of personal data**".
